

<u>Journalist</u>: A journalist or reporter gathers information on news, current affairs, important events and matters of public interest and writes articles about them for newspapers, magazines and the internet.

Discuss the job cards, what do you do for each of these jobs? Who do you think does these jobs? Match the jobs to the names and ages and justify choices. What do you notice?


# **Zoom Meteor Shower**

Choose 2 pages within the book. Identify which animals are 'producers', 'consumers', 'predators' and 'prey'. Construct a food chain from this information.





# How Big?!


Research the size of some of the animals in the book. Use this information to measure out the size of these animals. This can be done in the playground using chalk. What do you notice? Can you put these in an order?































