<u>Data Scientist</u>: Data scientists combine their IT, statistical and mathematical knowledge to help businesses make accurate decisions. They collect, extract and analyse large amounts of structured and unstructured raw data from a variety of sources to make predictions and identify trends based on their findings.

Pattern Cutter: Pattern cutters work from fashion designers' plans to make the templates used for making garments. Pattern graders take the patterns made by pattern cutters and produce scaled up and scaled down versions, to produce the same garment in different sizes.

Using different colours and shapes design a repeating pattern to create a jumper for Brenda to wear to the party.


Counting Sheep

Follow the instructions to make a bird feeder. Hang it outside and see what wildlife is attracted to it.


Bird Watch

CES: I believe I can do any job.

<u>Veterinary Nurse:</u> Veterinary nurses (vet nurses) help veterinary surgeons (vets) treat and care for sick and injured animals. Although most vet nurses work mainly with small animals, in some cases they care for farm animals, horses or zoo animals.

<u>Dog Handler:</u> Dog handlers work with specially trained dogs to help prevent and detect criminal activity and search for missing persons. They are responsible for looking after, feeding and keeping the dogs under control. Dog handlers mainly work for the police, the Armed Forces, customs and excise or private security firms.














Grass Sandwich
