

# **Activity/Challenge:**


Create a snapping crocodile.

Using egg cartons or other cardboard construct a crocodile's head which opens and close. Butterfly pins can be used to connect the top and bottom of the mouth together. Decorate with paint, tissue or other media. Then use the crocodile mouth to pick out alphabet letters from an assortment of objects.

#### **DYW link:**
